Diners, Drive-ins and Dives (Season 10): In this new season, join Guy Fieri as he visits classic 'greasy spoon' spots. We follow Guy on a journey to Kansas City, Missouri. 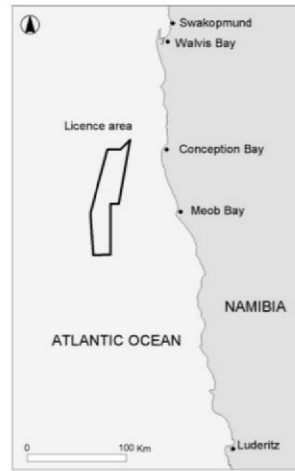

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED SANDPIPER/MEOB MARINE PHOSPHATE MINING PROJECT

Invitation to Participate



Namibian Marine Phosphate (Pty) Ltd proposes to mine an estimated 5-million tons of phosphate rich sediments annually from a deposit along the Namibian coast (see map), using proven deep water dredging techniques. The product will then be transferred to shore in Walvis Bay where the phosphate sands will be separated from other marine sediments. The proposed project thus has *two components*, namely *marine* and *terrestrial (land-based)*. Separate Environmental Impact Assessments (EIAs) will be undertaken for each of the two components.

Jeremy Midgley & Associates, in association with Enviro Dynamics cc and a team of specialists, have been appointed to conduct the EIA processes. The public participation process will now commence, first focusing on the marine component. A similar process, focusing on the terrestrial component, will follow at a later stage.

How can you get involved?

- At this initial stage of the project we invite you to register as a stakeholder by Friday, 16 September 2011 in order to participate throughout the EIA processes. Registered stakeholders will receive a Background Information Document, ongoing feedback throughout the project and will be able to submit comments on the process.
- Attend a public meeting: Focus on the *Marine* component (meetings focussing on the terrestrial component will be advertised at a later stage).
